

# **Hope Happens**

#### FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR JAN.....

In a previous church where I served as pastor, the youth had a "rock ministry" of sorts. They would gather as a group (and sometimes as a congregation) to paint and decorate small flat stones that would later be distributed in local parks and other "random" public places. On the back of each stone was a stamped message from the church and, although I'm doubtful that anyone who found one of those stones ever came to visit the church, it was a lot of fun painting, distributing, and witnessing to our faith, through "rock talk".

As we are nearing Palm Sunday and Easter, I'm reminded of Luke's description of Jesus' answer to the Pharisees, as they tried to quiet down the exuberant cries of the disciples as Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on the back of a colt, palm branches waving. Jesus answered the Pharisee's pleas for quieting the disciples ... "I tell you, if my followers were silent, the stones would shout out." Luke 19:40

Jesus is reminding them (and us!) that nothing can silence this outcry of hope and joy! In keeping with the topic of our Lenten series on God's magnificent creation, the Living Bible paraphrase says it like this: *If the people keep quiet, the stones* along the road will burst into cheers!" (verse 40)

In this time when hope and joy may appear to be more a dream than reality, when it seems that humanity has gone off the rails, we are reminded through the Easter story that hope prevails even in the throes of death. God's faithful promise and presence will endure forever, cheering us on, reminding us to celebrate the Good News that Christ has risen and our hearts are full of light.

Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?" Matthew 6: 26-27

The worship service already is available on YouTube. We've been streaming the service live to YouTube on Sunday mornings. Recordings of the current and previous services are available, too.





#### **Western Berks Shepherding**



#### What happens at the Easter Egg Hunt?


